



Beef Steaks

with Ratatouille

Grass-fed beef steaks served with a delicious, quick and easy stove-top ratatouille packed full of vegetables.

Switch it up!

If you have some extra time on your hands you can bake your ratatouille in the oven. Thinly slice the vegetables, arrange them in an oven dish and pour over tinned tomatoes and seasoning. Bake until tender.

FROM YOUR BOX

SMALL EGGPLANT	1
ZUCCHINI	1
RED CAPSICUM	1
TINNED TOMATOES	400g
BEEF STEAKS	300g
ROCKET LEAVES	1 bag (60g)

FROM YOUR PANTRY

oil for cooking, salt, pepper, dried oregano, balsamic vinegar


KEY UTENSILS

2 frypans

NOTES

Add some crushed garlic, or fresh rosemary or oregano if you have some on hand.

You can stir any resting juices from the steak into the ratatouille for extra flavour.



1. SAUTÉ THE VEGETABLES

Heat a large frypan over medium-high heat with **oil.** Dice eggplant, zucchini and capsicum. Add to pan as you go. Cook for 5 minutes until vegetables begin to soften.



2. SIMMER THE SAUCE

Stir in tinned tomatoes, 1/2 tin water, 2 tsp dried oregano and 2 tsp balsamic vinegar (see notes). Cook, semi-covered, stirring occasionally for 10-15 minutes until thickened. Season with salt and pepper.



3. COOK THE STEAK

Meanwhile, heat a frypan over mediumhigh heat. Coat steaks with oil, salt and pepper. Cook for 2-4 minutes each side or until cooked to your liking. Set aside to rest (see notes).



4. DRESS THE ROCKET

In a bowl whisk together **2 tsp balsamic vinegar, salt and pepper.** Add rocket leaves and toss until well coated.



5. FINISH AND SERVE

Divide ratatouille among plates. Serve with dressed rocket leaves and steak.
